## 1. Background

Upper Tana Natural Resources Management Project is an eight year (2012-2020) project funded by Government of Kenya, International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD), Spanish Trust Fund and the Local community. The goal of the project is to "contribute to reduction of rural poverty in the Upper Tana river catchment". This goal is pursued via two development objectives which reflect the poverty-environment nexus namely (i) increased sustainable food production and incomes for poor rural households living in the project area; and (ii) sustainable management of natural resources for provision of environmental services. The project is covering 24 river basins and the tributaries of the four (4)

- ii. Provide community cash contribution ( 3-10%) and materials and labour (**7 -20%**) or a combination of both depending on the category as specified in the Matching Grants Manual;
- Open designated bank accounts in reputable commercial banks.; iii. Form three sub-committees i.e. finance ,procurement and iv.
- monitoring and evaluation; b) **During implementation**
- The groups will be required to fully meet the balance of their community contribution depending on the category
- The groups will be required to implement soil and water ii.
